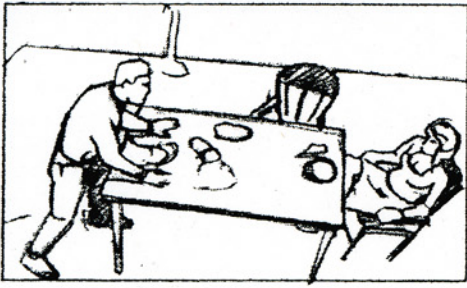
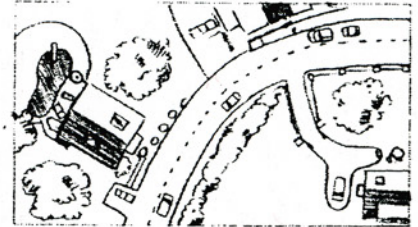


ANGLE

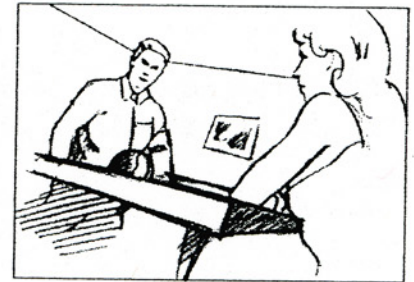


High angle: A shot taken from an angle above the object.

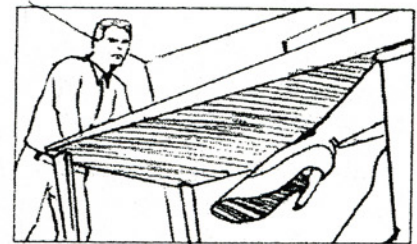
Aerial shot: A very high angle shot, often accomplished with a helicopter.



Low angle: A shot taken from the placement of the camera below the object.



High Hat shot: A very low angle shot positioned as if it were a hat's height off the floor. The name is taken from a piece of equipment called a high hat which is designed to hold a camera.



3/4 Shot: A shot that is positioned halfway between a frontal angle and a profile. Can be either a frontal or a back shot.



Profile: Shot from a side angle.



Staight on or Frontal shot: When the camera is looking directly at the object.
